IMPORTANT NOTES

Any skater who is, or has ever been, an Elite, Advanced, Certified, or Registered coach is not eligible to skate in any Bronze event.

Any adult division skater who is an Elite, Advanced, Certified or Registered coach, and wishes to receive coaching credentials for the National Championships in a given year MUST choose to skate GOLD skill level for that skating season.

Any skater who, since 2006, placed first, second, or third in an event at a National Championship in which there were six or more skaters or teams, may not skate in any Bronze event in that discipline.

At Regional Championships, skaters may challenge up to the next skill level in the division for which they qualify. (i.e. skaters may skate Bronze and Silver skill levels or Silver and Gold skill levels.) If the skater/team qualifies for the National Championships in both skill levels, the skater/team may skate ONLY ONE skill level at the National Championships.

AR06.01 FEDERATIONS

AR06.01.01 Competition within the adult sport of roller figure skating as governed by USA Roller Sports (USARS) shall be divided into five disciplines

- (a) Team Dance
- (b) Solo Dance
- (c) Compulsory Figures
- (d) Loops
- (e) Free Skating

AR06.01.02 The Figure Skating Technical Committee shall have such authority over the disciplines as shall be provided in the rules and regulations of the Board of Directors

AR06.01.03 The adult roller figure skating disciplines shall consist of the following divisions

- (a) **TEAM DANCE** – (Mixed couples) Bronze Division 1, Bronze Division 2, Bronze Division 3, Silver Division 1, Silver Division 2, Silver Division 3, Gold Division 1, Gold Division 2, Gold Division 3, Classic International, and Classic Gold
- (b) **SOLO DANCE** – (Individuals, Co-ed) Bronze Division 1 and Bronze Division 2.
SOLO DANCE – (Individuals, separate men and women) Bronze Division 3, Silver Division 1, Silver Division 2, Silver Division 3, Gold Division 1, Gold Division 2, Gold Division 3, Classic International, and Classic Gold.
- (c) **COMPULSORY FIGURES** – (Individuals, separate men and women) Bronze Division 1, Bronze Division 2, Bronze Division 3, Silver Division 1, Silver Division 2, Silver Division 3, Gold Division 1, Gold Division 2, Gold Division 3, and Classic Gold.
- (d) **LOOPS** – (Individuals, separate men and women) Classic and Classic Gold.
- (e) **FREE SKATING** – (Individuals, separate men and women) Classic Singles

AR06.02 ROLLER FIGURE SKATING EVENTS

AR06.02.01 ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR ADULT ROLLER FIGURE SKATING

- (a) The competitive age of skaters who enter any contest during a skating season (September 1st through August 31st) in which age determines eligibility shall be decided by the age of the contestant on January 1st of that competitive season. The competitive age for mixed couples shall be decided by the age of the younger skater.
- (b) Skaters are permitted to participate in both TEAM DANCE and SOLO DANCE, as they are eligible.
- (c) Skaters are permitted to participate in both COMPULSORY FIGURES and LOOPS, as they are eligible.
- (d) Skaters may participate in one Division (Division 1, Division 2, or Division 3) based on age, and one Classic division in each discipline. See rule AR06.02.05 Challenge Up requirements.

AR06.02.02 SPECIAL ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR COACHES

- (a) Any skater who is, or has ever been, an Elite, Advanced, Certified, or Registered coach is not eligible to skate in any Bronze event.

- (b) Any adult division skater who is an Elite, Advanced, Certified or Registered coach, and wishes to receive coaching credentials for the National Championships in a given year MUST choose to skate GOLD skill level for that skating season.

AR06.02.03 BRONZE LOOK BACK RULE

- (a) Any skater who, since 2006, placed first, second, or third in an event at a National Championship in which there were six or more skaters or teams, may not skate in any Bronze event in that discipline.

AR06.02.04 COMBINED FIGURE AND LOOP EVENTS (RESERVED)

AR06.02.05 CHALLENGE UP RULES

At Regional Championships, skaters may challenge up to the next skill level in the division for which they qualify. (i.e. skaters may skate Bronze and Silver skill levels or Silver and Gold skill levels.) If the skater/team qualifies for the National Championships in both skill levels, the skater/team may skate ONLY ONE skill level at the National Championships.

AR06.02.20 ADULT ROLLER FIGURE SKATING COMPETITIVE REQUIREMENTS

AR06.02.21 TEAM AND SOLO DANCE

- (a) The dances will vary for each level in Team and Solo dance and may be determined by consulting the annual Adult Roller Figure Skating Competitive Requirements section of this General Rules Manual.
- (b) All Solo and Team dance events will be skated in flights of two (2), except, if there is an odd number of skaters or teams, one flight will consist of one (1) skater or team. One skater or team flights will skate the same number of repetitions or the same time requirement as two skater or two team flights.
- (c) GOLD DIVISION 1, GOLD DIVISION 2, GOLD DIVISION 3, and CLASSIC GOLD dance events will skate three (3) dances in each round of competition (elimination or final). All other divisions will skate two (2) dances in each round of competition.
- (d) All dances, except Classic Gold dance events, will skate four (4) repetitions of the dance, beginning with the first step of the dance as indicated on the published dance diagram and ending with the last step as indicated on the published dance diagram. Classic Gold dance events will skate each dance for two (2) minutes.
- (e) In two skater or two team flights, the skater or team with the lower number will begin the first dance first. The skater or team with the higher number will begin the second dance first. For Gold and Classic Gold events, the skater or team with the lowest number will begin the third dance first.
- (f) In one skater or one team flights, the skater or team will be judged on the first dance during the first two repetitions of the dance and judged on the second dance during the third and fourth repetition of the dance. For Gold events, the third dance will be judged during the first two repetitions of the dance. However, judging for Classic Gold events will be at the discretion of the judge.
- (g) All Classic events will be skated as a final only.

- (h) All dance events will skate to organ music, except for Classic International Team Dance and Classic International Solo Dance, which will skate to orchestral music.

AR06.02.22 COMPULSORY FIGURES

- (a) The figures will vary for each level and may be determined by consulting the annual Adult Roller Figure Skating Competitive Requirements section of this General Rules Manual.
- (b) GOLD DIVISION 1, GOLD DIVISION 2, GOLD DIVISION 3, and CLASSIC GOLD compulsory figure events will skate three (3) figures in each round of competition (elimination or final). All other divisions will skate two (2) figures in each round of competition.
- (c) All compulsory figure events will skate two repetitions of each figure.

AR06.02.23 LOOPS

- (a) The figures will vary for each division and may be determined by consulting the annual Adult Roller Figure Skating Competitive Requirements section of this General Rules Manual.
- (b) CLASSIC GOLD loops will skate three loops. Classic loops will skate two loop circles.
- (c) All loop events will skate two repetitions of each loop.

AR06.02.24 FREE SKATING

- (a) Two scores will be given by the judges in CLASSIC SINGLES. The (A) mark shall be for Technical Merit and the (B) mark shall be for Artistic Impression. Failure to attempt required content or exceeding the required limitations will result in a five (5) point deduction for each and every infraction. The referee will penalize a skater who skates more than the specified time.

AR06.02.51 **BRONZE DIVISION 1 TEAM DANCE** (age 18-49) events shall consist of registered skaters where at least one skater is between the ages of 18 and 49. See rule ARX.02.02 for special eligibility rules for coaches. See rule ARX.04.03 for bronze look back restrictions

AR06.02.52 **BRONZE DIVISION 2 TEAM DANCE** (age 50-64) events shall consist of registered skaters where both skaters are at least age 50 and one skater is no older than age 64. See rule ARX.02.02 for special eligibility rules for coaches. See rule ARX.04.03 for bronze look back restrictions

AR06.02.53 **BRONZE DIVISION 3 TEAM DANCE** (age 65 and over) events shall consist of registered skaters where both skaters are at least age 65. See rule ARX.02.02 for special eligibility rules for coaches. See rule ARX.04.03 for bronze look back restrictions.

AR06.02.54 **SILVER DIVISION 1 TEAM DANCE** (age 18-49) events shall consist of registered skaters where at least one skater is between the ages of 18 and 49. See rule ARX.02.02 for special eligibility rules for coaches.

AR06.02.55 **SILVER DIVISION 2 TEAM DANCE** (age 50-64) events shall consist of registered skaters where both skaters are at least age 50 and one skater is no older than age 64. See rule ARX.02.02 for special eligibility rules for coaches.

AR06.02.56 **SILVER DIVISION 3 TEAM DANCE** (age 65 and over) events shall consist of registered skaters where both skaters are at least age 65. See rule ARX.02.02 for special eligibility rules for coaches.

AR06.02.57 **GOLD DIVISION 1 TEAM DANCE** (age 18 and over) events shall consist of registered skaters age 18 and over.

AR06.02.58 **GOLD DIVISION 2 TEAM DANCE** (age 18-54) events shall consist of registered skaters where both skaters are at least age 18 and one skater is no older than age 54.

AR06.02.59 **GOLD DIVISION 3 TEAM DANCE** (age 55 and over) events shall consist of registered skaters where both skaters are at least age 55.

AR06.02.121 CLASSIC SINGLES (age 18 and over) events shall consist of registered skaters age 18 and over.

- (a) Time limit: No minimum, maximum 2.30
- (b) Content requirements: Maximum of 5 jumps, may be single, 1 ½, or double rotation; 2 jump combinations; maximum of 3 spins, in which 2 may be a combination/change spin (may use camel or sit positions). No repeated items (spins or jumps) unless used in combination. One sequence of primary, secondary, or advanced footwork must be included.
